

The launch of the project involving brackish water treatment facilities for the City of Zouerate is a historical event for the City's population.

This project will enable the town's drinking water requirements, estimated at about 3,800 m<sup>3</sup> per day, to be met by increasing production to 4,000 m<sup>3</sup> per day.

The cost of the project is MRO 2,157 billion, financed with equity capital from SNIM.

Work on this project, which includes building a brackish water treatment plant and related facilities (pipes, reservoirs, and pum-ping stations) will end in late 2013.
